## SUSR FORMAL CONSULTATION

- The SUSR Welsh Government consultation has now come to an end. A total of 48 responses from stakeholders were received.
- The SUSR team are now formulating responses to each of the consultation answers to be published as a 'Summary of responses'.
- The responses received will be categorised by theme which will be analysed by the SUSR team. This piece of work will also be published as part of the 'Summary of responses'.

### BACKGROUND

Create a single review process where a multiagency approach is required, incorporating the following review processes Adult Practice **Review; Child Practice Review; Domestic** Homicide Review: Mental health Homicide Review; **Offensive Weapon** Homicide Review. The final report is then used to inform professional practice via the Wales Safeguarding Repository.

#### **PROGRESS TO DATE**

 A paper has been drafted by the SUSR team to address issues surrounding the limited capacity of Reviewers across Wales. This paper was presented to the Stakeholder Reference Group and will now be refined before sending to DMSS Julie Morgan for consideration.

#### WALES SAFEGUARDING REPOSITORY UPDATE

 The WSR team hosted a number of testers at Cardiff University to test the searchability of the Repository. The testing was attended by stakeholders from a wide range of different agencies and organisations.



#### **NEXT STEPS**

- All responses will be analysed, and the 'Summary of responses' will be published within 12 weeks of the close of the consultation.
- The SUSR Ministerial Board will then review the findings and the SUSR team make final amendments to the Statutory Guidance ready for publication (forecast for Spring 24)
