The first SUSR Dissemination Event will be held in Venue Cymru, Llandudno on the 20th of May 2025. Speakers will include:

- Dr Bethan Davies, Research Associate, Wales Safeguarding Repository, Cardiff University - Showcasing the Wales Safeguarding Repository in action and how to use this tool to improve SUSR recommendation writing
- Professor Michelle McManus, Co-Director for the Institute for Children's Futures, Manchester Metropolitan University - Key learning from CPRs/APRs in Wales for developing SUSR reports and recommendations.
- Dr James Rowlands, Assistant Professor in Sociology, Durham University - Sharing his experience and research into the involvement of perpetrators and their families in Domestic Abuse-Related Death Reviews and the risks and benefits of, and approaches to, this type of engagement.
