

#### The Problem

- Hate in our communities on the rise over 123,000 reported last year in England & Wales (Home Office, 2024)
- Significant under-reporting remains by practitioners & the public due to a lack of formal mechanism & process (Nouri, 2022).
- Visuals are even more likely to be under-reported yet impact so many!
- Future Users/Beneficiaries (councils & partners) have expressed the need for a formalised, systematic and mandatory system shared by all.























Are we doing enough?

### Local Profile

Key Takeaways from training delivery across South Wales delivered from 2018-2024:

- Consistent rise in hate graffiti
- Lack of awareness & understanding of the importance of visuals
- Need for better systems for reporting & monitoring
- No clear lines of communication between CSSPs & local partners





#### **Validation**

- Long-standing working relationship with councils across Wales
  - Training (Swansea, Bridgend & Cardiff)
  - Co-design of training package needs & app
- Proof of concept: co-Design with Bridgend County Council –
   Welsh Government funded SMART PARTNERSHIP £124,000
- Bridgend very much invested in the project and have signed up for continued use of the service as it saves them time, money and resources.
- CTP using the service
- Sustained media, academic & policy interest

### Next Steps

#### **Current Activities:**

- Commercialisation of StreetSnap app and training package through UKRI ARC Funding
- Integrating AI into app to more efficiently categorise images through ESRC Impact Acceleration Funding
- Seeking councils/policing services keen to roll out app and/or government funding to reach across 5-6 councils



#### Cost Breakdown

- Opportunity to revolutionise approach to hate visual reporting across the UK
- Low-cost solution maximum results
- Yearly costs: (for use by council and ALL partners)
  - Priced at £0.01 per person in the population plus delivery costs (based on current population data)
  - Ceredigion £2751 (per annum)
  - Swansea £5200 (per annum)
  - Rhondda Cynon Taf £4377 (per annum)
  - All Wales Roll-Out Year 1: £50,000



## Flip the Streets

- Sister Project to StreetSnap
- Uses instances of hate graffiti as a starting point for conversations with young people
- Destigmatisation of conversations around race and protective characteristics
- Enables communities to inspire change











#### Cost Breakdown

- Work with a variety of partners from local councils, to building management companies and NGOs.
- One-off costs of £1500 per project to include work with community, design of mural co-produced with community and creation of mural and event day
