RCRP- Phases

Phase 1 and 2

- P1 Concern for Welfare implemented across Wales system allows for escalation and learning from practice
- P2 AWOL and Walk out from Health facilities
- Implemented
- Limited impact on LAs but potential for significant impact on LHBs and link to public concern for welfare

Phase 3

- P3 Transportation
- Transportation/Conveyance on going challenges with conveyance that impact daily on AMHPs
- There is an urgent need to put a sustainable solution in place that ensures people are conveyed in a timely manner that is dignified
- Need to ensure good LA engagement especially in relation to LAs responsibilities for providing Approved Mental Health Professionals (AMHPs). AMHPs and LAs have a significant role to coordinate conveyance for MHA Assessments which is sometimes not fully understood and appreciated

Phase 4

- P4 S136
- Need to ensure good LA engagement especially in relation to LAs responsibilities for providing Approved Mental Health Professionals (AMHPs). AMHPs and LAs have a significant role which is sometimes not fully understood and appreciated

LAs are not an emergency service and are not resourced to operate like one so this does need to be considered when discussing roles, responsibilities and expectations.
